



Littlest Green Monster

SIZES

Approximately: 15.5cm (6 in)

YOU WILL NEED

Patons Smoothie DK 100% Acrylic
(200m per 100g ball)

A small amount of green yarn.

1 x safety eye

Polyester stuffing

A small amount of white felt for eye and tooth.

1 button

Red and white embroidery thread.

3mm crochet hook

Tapestry needle

Note: Yarn amounts given are based on average requirements and are approximate.

TENSION

18 sts and 20 rows to 10cm (4 ins) dc using
3mm needles

Use larger or smaller needles if necessary to
obtain correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS

Dc = Double Crochet (US Single crochet)

Sts = stitches

Yrh = yarn round hook

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Dec 1 = decrease 1 st (insert hook in next st,
yrh, draw through loop) twice, yrh, draw through
all 3 loops on hook.

Inc = increase 1 st: work 2 dec in next st.

LEGS (MAKE 2)

Using 3mm hook and green coloured yarn make
a magic ring.

Rnd 1: dc 8 sts in the centre of magic ring. 8 sts.

Rnd 2: (Inc 1, dc in next st) 4 times. 12 sts.

Rnd 3: (Inc1, dc in each of next 2 sts) 4 times 16
sts.

Work 8 rounds straight.

At the end of first leg fasten off.

Work second leg alike, but do not end round.

Keep yarn hanging from this piece.

ARMS (MAKE 2)

Using 3mm hook and green coloured yarn make
a magic ring.

Rnd 1: dc 8 sts in the centre of magic ring. 8 sts.

Rnd 2: (Inc 1, dc in next st) 4 times. 12 sts.

Work 6 rounds straight.

Rnd 9: (Dec 1, dc in next st) 4 times. 8 sts.

Fasten off. Stuff the arms with stuffing.

BODY

With crochet hook in the last sts of the second
leg, continue to dc around the 16 sts of first leg.
Place marker. 32 sts.

Continue to work in spirals across all 32 sts.

Work 12 rounds straight.

From marker at the back of the monster, dc 6
sts. Attach the arms by closing the top of the
arm opening and dc 2 sts of arms tog with the
next dc on the body. Work across all double 4
sts of the arm and 4 sts of the body together.

The arm will then be securely attached. Dc 12
sts. Attach the next arm by dc the doubled 4 sts
of arm and 4sts of the body together. Dc 6 sts.
Work 6 rounds straight.

Divide the head:

From the marker dc 4 sts.

Triangle: Dec 1, dc 6 sts. Turn.

Dec 1, dc 5 sts. Turn. Dec 1, dc 4 sts. Turn.

Dec 1, dc 3 sts. Turn Dec 1, dc 2 sts. Dec 2tog.

Fasten off.

Repeat triangle shaping three times.

TO FINISH OFF

Stuff the legs and body. Cut a small triangle for
the tooth and attach using white thread. Using
red embroidery thread, chain stitch across the
face to create a mouth. Cut a small circle of felt
larger than the safety eye. Make a small cut in
the middle the circle and push the safety eye
through the felt and the head and secure with
plastic backing. Sew as small white button on to
head for second eye. Stuff the rest of the
body/head. Halve both ear triangles and pin
together and pin both sides of the central head
triangle together. Slip stitch across the three
triangles to close the head. Have fun scaring
members of your family.
