One's Royal Keyring

Emma Varnam

SIZES

Approximately: cm (in) wide and cm (in) tall

YOU WILL NEED

Sirdar Snuggly Baby Bamboo DK 80% Bamboo
20% Wool

(94m per 50g ball)

1 x Yellow Submarine 157 (A)

1 x Toy Box Red 162 (B)

Some wooden beads or sequins for jewels

5cm (2in) of thin ribbon

Polyester stuffing

A keyring

3mm crochet needle

Tapestry needle

Note: Yarn amounts given are based on
average requirements and are approximate.

TENSION

6 sts and 7 rows to (1 in) in double crochet (UK)
using 3mm needle

Use larger or smaller needles if necessary to
obtain correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS

Dc = Double Crochet (US Single crochet)

Ch = Chain stitch

Sl st = slip stitch

St(s) = stitch(es)

R = Rows

Dec 1 = decrease 1 st (insert hook in next st,
yrh, draw through loop) twice, yrh, draw through
all 3 loops on hook.

Inc = increase 1 st: work 2 dec in next st.

RS = Right side.

CROWN (MAKE 2)

Using 3mm crochet needle and (A) Chain st 16
sts.

Foundation row: 1 dc in second st from hook, 1
dc in each rem ch. (15 sts) Turn.

R1: 1ch (does not count as a dc) 1 dc in each dc
to end.(15 sts) Turn.

R2: 1ch (does not count as a dc) 1 dc in each dc
to end. (15 sts) Turn.

Picot Row: (Working always in the back loop of
each st in this row) *Ch 2, sl st into the back of
first st. Slip st into back of next 2 sts. Rep from *
to last st. Sl st into back of last st, ch 2, sl st.
Turn.

R3: Join (B) and 1 ch, 1 dc in the back of the sts
of the Picot row to end. (15 sts) Turn.

R4: 1ch (does not count as a dc) 1 dc in each dc
to end. (15 sts) Turn.

R5: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) In 1, dc 13 sts,
in 1. (17sts) Turn.

R6: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) In 1, dc 15 sts,
in 1. (19sts) Turn.

R7: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) 1 dc in each
dc to end. (19sts) Turn.

R8: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) 1 dc in each
dc to end. (19sts) Turn.

Crown is now divided into two sections. Work on
each section separately.

R9: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) dc 7 sts, dec
1. (8 sts) Turn.

R10: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) dec 1, dc 4,
dec 1. (6 sts) Turn.

R11: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) dec 1, dc 2,
dec 1 (4 sts) Fasten off.

R9: With RS facing, miss central dc, rejoin yarn
(B) 1 ch (does not count as a dc) dec 1, dc 7
sts. (8 sts) Turn.

R10: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) dec 1, dc 4,
dec 1. (6 sts) Turn.

R11: 1 ch (does not count as a dc) dec 1, dc 2,
dec 1 (4 sts) Fasten off.

TO FINISH OFF

Choose one side of the crown and using (A) slip
stitch a line from the top of the crown down to
the brim. Then using (A) slip stitch another line
around the outside of the cherry red crown
cushion. Loop the ribbon through the key ring
and secure in place between both sides of the
top of the crown. Using embroidery thread sew
both sides of crown together leaving a small
hole in order to fill the crown with a little
polyester stuffing. Then sew this hole together.
Place 5 beads or sequins evenly across one
side of the crown brim. Sew securely using
embroidery thread. At the base of the ribbon the
middle of crown, sew a large bead for ultimate
regal effect.
