

Fancy Lanyard

SIZES

Length: 80 cm (31.5 in)

Width: 1cm (0.4 in)

YOU WILL NEED

Rico Design Essentials Cotton Lurex
(approx 170m per 50g)

A small amount of 04 FUCHSIA (H)

A small amount of this yarn

1 metal clasp

40 beads if you like

1 x button for decoration

2mm & 2.5mm crochet hook

Tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS

dc=double crochet, ch =chain stitch

rem = remaining

(Pattern uses UK dc in the US substitute for
stitch for sc)



PATTERN

Using 2.5mm crochet hook Ch 161 sts.

Foundation row: 1 dc in second st from hook,
1 dc in each rem ch. (160 sts) Turn.

Row 1: Ch1, 1dc in each dc to end.(160 sts)

Turn.

Row 2: Ch1, 1dc in each dc to end.(160 sts)

Fasten off.

TO FINISH OFF

Thread one end of the lanyard through the
metal clasp and then use a tail of yarn to sew
one end of the lanyard to the other, making a
loop. Sew a button at the base of the lanyard
for decoration.

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BEADED VERSION

Thread 40 beads on to your yarn before you
start crocheting. Work the foundation row
and then replace row 1 with this version:

Row 1: Ch1, *dc 3, bring one bead along the
yarn and sit it next to the last dc made, then
1 dc in next st, rep from * to end.

Continue to work pattern.
